A Typical Day at VIP Camp

7:00-8:00: **Arrival Time** *Students have the option of doing structured stretching, working on a portfolio project, or crafts as other students arrive*

8:00-8:50: **First Class** *Based on their age-level group, students will go to one of 4 classes: Acting, Play Production, Music, or Dance. Students take this class for 6 weeks, then it switches.*

8:50-9:00: **Break Time** *This is a bathroom break time, or students can send inter-camp mail, or eat snacks*

9:00-9:50: **First Rehearsal** *Students will work on their performances (to be performed one per semester)*

9:50-10:00: **Break Time**

10:00-11:00: **VIP Time** *Students will break up into their group with their team leaders to work on self-esteem and emotional training, as well as team building and journaling.*

11:00-1:30: **Lunch/Fun Time** *Students will eat lunch (brought from home), and then have the option of several activities to participate in (such as crafts, recreation, movie time, etc.)*

1:30-2:30: **Second Class**

2:30-3:00: **Second Rehearsal**

3:00-5:00: **Pick Up Time** *Students can be picked up anytime between 3:00-5:00. Students will be able to participate in crafts, recreation, extra rehearsal, and portfolio projects during this time*
